Live it

HOBART

Located on the Sandy Bay campus is a choice of three residences: John Fisher College, Christ College and the University Apartments.

Location

All three on-campus residences are situated at the top of College Road in Sandy Bay. They are set amid natural bush providing a habitat for native fauna. The residences command sweeping views of the city of Hobart, Sandy Bay and the Derwent River, with Mount Wellington providing an impressive backdrop.

Access

From the University on-campus accommodation it's a 15-minute walk to the lively Sandy Bay shopping precinct. A pleasant 30-minute walk from on-campus residences to Hobart city centre provides easy access to the world-acclaimed and charming Salamanca Market, historic yet vibrant Battery Point and the relaxing, ever fascinating Sullivans Cove waterfront.

If you don't fancy a gentle walk in the fresh Hobart air, regular metropolitan bus services provide an easy and affordable link between the University, Hobart and suburbs.

A courtesy bus is also available during the academic year to take students to the University's city campuses of the Tasmanian School of Art, Conservatorium of Music and Medical Science Precinct.

LAUNCESTON

Centrally located on the Newnham campus is a choice of three residences: Kerslake Hall, Investigator Hall and Leprena.

Location

The on-campus residences are set in tranquil grounds and provide easy access to all on-campus facilities. Your new home is close enough to enable you to prepare lunch or retrieve books between classes.

The city of Launceston is the nation's third oldest city, founded in 1805. Attractions include Seaport offering various dockside dining facilities, along with the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery at Inveresk, which incorporates the University's Academy of Arts and the School of Architecture and Design.

One of the city's most stunning and famous natural features is the Cataract Gorge, where you'll find picturesque walking and hiking tracks, abseiling and rock climbing. Other world-class attractions are the Victorian gardens with roaming peacocks, suspension bridge, an outdoor swimming pool and the world's longest single-span chairlift.

Access

From the Newnham campus it's an easy 10-minute walk to the Mowbray shopping centre and its supermarkets, shops, banks and post office. A regular bus service runs from the University through Mowbray, past the Inveresk campus and on to the city centre.
