UTAS Eligibility to apply for exchange

- Be currently enrolled as a full-time student at UTAS for the period of exchange
- Completed at least one full year of study at UTAS
- Achieved good grades - Credit average or above

UTAS closing dates

For exchange students the closing dates are:

- 15 March for commencing August/September
- 1 August for commencing January

Please note the University of California has earlier deadlines than UTAS:

You need to apply one year in advance i.e. apply by 15 March for an exchange commencing either August (Spring) of the same year or January (Fall) the following year.

Application procedure

The whole procedure from application to confirmation and departure can take up to 6 months. All applicants will be notified of their application status three weeks after the closing date.

Research the institutions on the UTAS website to make your choice. Speak to your Course Coordinator about course selection and any compulsory subjects that you will need to take. They may also be able to make suggestions of a good match for an exchange.

The process is as follows:

1. Application approval and ranking by Faculty
2. Provisional approval by host institution (exchange is not guaranteed because of agreement requirements)
3. Application to the host institution including subjects preferred for the exchange period
4. UTAS Course Approval form completed
5. Application for accommodation
6. Formal acceptance by the host institution for study period and accommodation
7. Visa application and flight bookings

Application checklist

Documentation to include with your application:

- One official academic transcript obtained from Student Administration
- A Curriculum Vitae (Resumé)
- Personal statement (maximum 500 words) explaining why you wish to go on exchange to your first preference institution
- One written academic reference

Accommodation

You will be provided with advice on accommodation options from the host institution when your application has been approved by them.

Visas

You will be provided with further advice from the host institution on the appropriate visa and process.

Students will need to apply for a student visa unless you have dual citizenship for the country of your study period. You cannot apply for a visa until you have received formal notification of acceptance from the host institution.
