Semester 2 results will be released at 9 am on Wednesday 6th July. To access your results, you will need to log on to the [eStudentCentre](#).

1. Please refer to the [examinations and results](#) pages on the UTAS website for important information about results.
2. If you do not get the results that you expected, then please first discuss with your lecturer/tutor. You may request a review of assessment- please refer to the information at: http://www.studentcentre.utas.edu.au/examinations_and_results/results/index.html
3. If you are sitting deferred exam papers, or have been offered supplementary exams, please read the information very carefully and follow the instructions provided.
4. If you are no longer in Australia, and have a supplementary exam, please contact Aga.Connor@utas.edu.au, the Exams Officer as soon as possible to find out if alternative arrangements can be made. You will be responsible for any costs involved (\$88 for postage, and exam supervision, if applicable). You will also be responsible for finding a suitable venue and supervisor (suitable venues includes schools, and the supervisor should be a staff member of the venue).

Help, I can't view my results

If you can log in to the eStudentCentre, but cannot view your results, you may have been debarred or had your enrolment cancelled by the Fees Committee.

- If you have been debarred, please read the information about [debarral](#) carefully.
- If you have had your enrolment cancelled by the Fees Committee, you may [apply to have your enrolment reinstated](#). Please read the information on the form carefully before you complete it and submit it. Please note that all outstanding fees MUST be paid, plus the reinstatement fee of \$200 before your application for reinstatement of enrolment will be considered.
- Even if you are debarred, it is important to check your results page. If you have been granted a supplementary exam, this result will still show even though the other results will be blocked. You must then check your personal exam timetable as soon as possible as these exams take place within a few days of the results release.

For continuing students.....

Please make sure that you are enrolled for semester 2. Enrol via the eStudentCentre if you have not already done so.

Your semester 1 results may affect your study progress and the choice of units that you can study in semester 2:

- If you have failed any units in sem 1, please seek advice from your Faculty about your study plan for sem 2.
- If your sem 1 results mean that you are unable to enrol in any units in sem 2, please make an appointment to discuss your options with your International Student Adviser

For students expecting to complete their studies in July.....

If you have passed all your units this semester –

- If you have completed all the units required in your course, you are now eligible to [graduate](#).
- You may [apply for a completion letter and/or your academic transcript](#) once the results are released.
- You may accept a conditional offer to do further studies at UTAS. If you wish to do further studies at UTAS, but have not yet applied, please look at the information about the [international student application process](#).

If you have not passed all your units this semester and you are not offered the opportunity to sit supplementary exams –

- Please seek advice from your School or Faculty officer for your study options
- If you have an offer for further studies starting in Semester 2, 2011, please contact the International Admissions officer to request a deferred offer with a new start date.
- If your student visa expires in July 2011, please [apply for a new eCoE](#) so that you can extend your student visa to complete your studies.

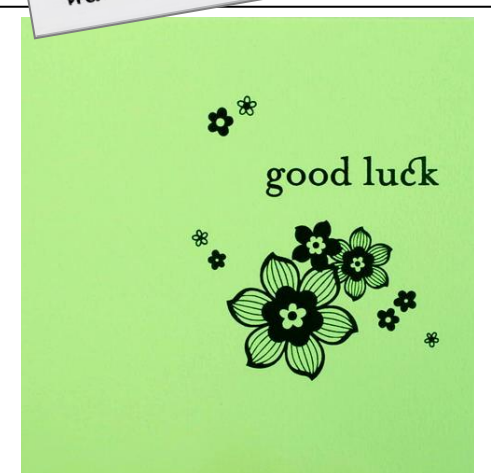
